Explanation





- With **Funds** you donate to a CEA fund, the fund managers then choose the organisations of which they expect most impact from (in that domain)
- **Regranting Organizations** are similar to funds, but the fund managers are not from CEA but from another organisation
- **Non-profit organisations** are organisations that spend the money. With a donation via this platform, the money flows via the CEA, so for recording purposes, you donate to CEA.






